2022 VIRGINIA HOM FUNG MEMORIAL YOUTH CHINESE LANGUAGE SCHOLARSHIP

House of China (HOC) in Balboa Park, is a non-profit cultural and education organization founded in 1935. The mission of HOC is to preserve, present and promote Chinese culture, cross-cultural friendship and understanding. HOC is open every Saturday and Sunday afternoon, and seasonal special events are held throughout the year.

The late Mrs. Virginia Hom Fung was a dedicated HOC officer passionate in Chinese culture and its advancement. A scholarship program was established in 1995 by HOC in her memory. HOC awards scholarships annually to San Diego County youths, 18 years of age and younger, who are currently enrolled in the local certified Chinese language schools in San Diego County. There are three groups in this program: beginner, intermediate and advanced (see below). The maximum number of submissions in each group from each Chinese school is set at 30.

Rules and regulations:

1. Applicants must be registered in local certified Chinese schools.
2. Essay must be submitted in original hand written format on 8.5 x 11(A4) standard size squared paper (方格纸). All essays must be written in WORD “portrait” format (not landscape format) from left to right, and top to bottom. Application form will be available on **January 24th** at each Chinese school.
3. Each application packet must include the followings:
 - a. the original copy of essay, (English version can be included for supplementary contents, but not required. No extra points will be given). **Please do not include student’s name, grade and name of school on essay.**
 - b. 3 additional Zerox copies of essay
 - c. A completed application form.
4. The essay packet must be **mailed or dropped off (no certified mail)** to:

Topic of the essay:

Beginner / Intermediate group: How To Beautify / Improve San Diego?

Advanced group: How Can Modern Technology Improve Our Environment?

Suggested guidelines of essay:

1. Identify the current environmental issues critical in San Diego
2. What are the solutions/ alternatives to apply in San Diego
3. What kind of impacts from the proposed options will be in the future at San Diego
4. Conclusion

Each winner, winner's parents, teacher, and a representative from each Chinese school are guests at the award ceremony on **Saturday, June 04, 2022**. Winners’ essays and photos will appear in HOC Newsletter, and local newspapers.

The criteria of each group:
